Meeting called to order at 9:02am

Minutes of December 13, 2022 Meeting: Motion to approve made by J. Sprague. Seconded by M. Fargo. Carried.

Raw Water Withdrawal Figures Status: Thus far, numbers for Palmyra and Canandaigua were submitted to Mr. Ohle. Invoices for the Watershed Inspection Program will be generated by the SWCD and mailed as soon as possible.

Agency Reports + General Discussion:

Ms. Webster noted SWCD employees are working on the annual report. Components of that will be highlighted in the Winter SWCD newsletter to be sent later this month. The NYSDOH-359 for the Watershed Inspection Program will soon be completed as well.

The Comprehensive Fee Schedule has not been updated in years so Mr. Ohle and Tad Gerace are compiling rates from the private sector. Adjustments may be made to keep our rates in line with the private sector.

Mr. Ohle stated the violation on Route 245 in Italy which has been a long term issue is mostly abated now and he continues to follow up on it. Mr. Aman asked what happens to onsite systems at properties where the residence or other structures burned. This does generally trigger an inspection.

Motion made by Mark Fargo and seconded by Jim Morse to approve costs associated with training for Tyler Ohle, including attendance at the annual Water Quality Symposium, stormwater training, conservation skills, and so forth during 2023. Carried.
